SCIENCE

Task 1: ARE YOU A BUCKET FILLER OR BUCKET DIPPER?

We all carry an **invisible bucket**—it holds our feelings.

When we show kindness, share, help, and speak kindly, we **fill someone's bucket**—and ours too.

But when we're unkind, ignore, or hurt others, we **dip from their bucket**—and our own.

Let's teach our children to **fill buckets**, not dip from them.

Materials:

- 2 A-4 Size sheets or plastic cups (buckets)
- Colourful & grey paper
- Scissors, glue, tape
- Crayons, markers, stickers, optional decorations

Steps:

1. Draw on sheet or decorate one cup with happy colours: label it "**Bucket Filler**" and draw a smiling face.
2. Draw on sheet or decorate the second cup with dull colours: label it "**Bucket Dipper**" and draw a sad face.
3. Cut small paper drops or hearts. Write kind actions on them (e.g. "I helped my friend") for the **Filler** bucket, and unkind actions (e.g. "I didn't share") for the **Dipper**.
4. Fill the buckets accordingly.
5. Display them as a daily reminder: "Am I filling or dipping today?"

Reflection:

- How did this make you feel?
- What can I do today to **fill someone's bucket**?
- How can I change dipping actions into filling ones?

 **Task 2:**Build a Mini Terrarium or Bottle Garden

Activity: Use a plastic bottle or jar to build a **mini ecosystem** with soil, stones, and small plants (like moss or grass).

Skills learned:

- Plant life cycle
- Water cycle in a closed system
- Importance of green spaces
